- ...longing for the presence of God (prioritizing his time). "How lovely is your tabernacle O Lord of Hosts! My soul longs, yes, even faints for the courts of the Lord; My heart and my flesh cry out for the living God." (Psalm 84:1-2 NKJV)

"...and all the people rose and worshiped, each man in his tent door. So the Lord spoke to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend..." (Exodus 33:10-11 NKJV)

 ...practicing the presence of God (prioritizing his private moments). Christian practices (Matthew 6:1-18 NKJV): "So when you give..." (v. 2)

"And when you pray..." (v. 5)

"When you fast..." (v. 16)

"... your Father, who sees in secret will reward you openly." (v. 18)
