

# Grace Group Discussion Guide

For the week of September 23 - 29, 2018

## Main Thought and Passages:

*"For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them." (Ephesians 2:10 ESV)*

- We are His "workmanship," or in other words His "masterpiece." God doesn't make mistakes.
- God created us on purpose and for a purpose. Each of us has a destiny and purpose.

*"And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose. For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son..." (Romans 8:28-29 ESV)*

- God uses everything about us (personalities, gifts, and life experiences) to equip us for our purpose.

*"For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope. <sup>12</sup>Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will hear you. <sup>13</sup>You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart." (Jeremiah 29:11-13 ESV)*

- We discover our purpose as we grow in our relationship with God.
- We are all created to make a difference for Christ in our families and on our campuses.
