Main Passages and Lessons:

"Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward..." (Colossians 3:23-24)

- The problem when we say "let go and let God" is that we place all of our problems in God's hands and assume that He will take care of it apart from us.
- God works with us, He doesn't do everything for us.
