Main Passages and Lessons:

"You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house." (Matthew 5:14-15)

- A light shines brighter the darker a room is. Jesus calls us to be a light in a world that is spiritually dark.
- We do that by living a holy life and not compromising or giving in to the world's expectation.

"In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." (Matthew 5:16)

- Our light shines brighter the more we obey God.
- As we obey God, others will notice and recognize what living for God really means.
- We reflect the love of God onto others through living a righteous life.

Discussion Questions

- What is one area you feel you often compromise your faith? What can you change/do in order to obey God in that situation?
- How do you see "darkness" on your campus? How do you think God is calling you to be a light?
