High School Discussion Guide

From Generation to Generation: For the week of November 13 - 19, 2022

Main Thought and Scriptures:

"For he issued his laws to Jacob; He gave his instructions to Israel. He commanded our ancestors to teach them to their children, so the next generation might know them—even the children not yet born—and they in turn will teach their own children." (Psalm 78:5-6 NLT)

"Get all the advice and instruction you can, so you will be wise the rest of your life. You can make many plans, but the Lord's purpose will prevail." (Proverbs 19:20-21 NLT)

"Good people leave an inheritance to their grandchildren, but the sinner's wealth passes to the godly." (Proverbs 13:22 NLT)

"Teach these things and insist that everyone learn them.Don't let anyone think less of you because you are young. Be an example to all believers in what you say, in the way you live, in your love, your faith, and your purity." (1 Timothy 4:11-12 NLT)

Part of the calling to live "beyond" is to live beyond our age group. Often we only think about our generation and what we need.
