# **High School Discussion Guide**

Living Beyond Our Walls: For the week of November 20 - 26, 2022

## Main Thought:

Zacchaeus was perhaps the most hated person in his community. He was a chief tax collector, meaning he worked for the oppressive Roman government by collecting taxes from his fellow Jews. Needless to say, tax collectors were not very welcomed by others—except by Jesus. Jesus invites Zacchaeus to a meal, much to the complaint of others, and shows Zacchaeus love and care. In response, Zacchaeus' heart transforms. There are people like Zacchaeus around us—those who might feel like outsiders—whom Jesus wants to reveal His love. Will we be like those who hated Zacchaeus, or will we be like Jesus and show them love and care?

## Main Scriptures:

"Meanwhile, Zacchaeus stood before the Lord and said, 'I will give half my wealth to the poor, Lord, and if I have cheated people on their taxes, I will give them back four times as much!' 
<sup>9</sup>Jesus responded, 'Salvation has come to this home today, for this man has shown himself to be a true son of Abraham. <sup>10</sup>For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost.'" (Luke 19:8-10 NLT)
