

# Faith Over Fear

*"While He was still speaking, someone came from the ruler of the synagogue's house, saying to him, 'Your daughter is dead. Do not trouble the Teacher.'<sup>50</sup> But when Jesus heard it, He answered him, saying, 'Do not be afraid; only believe, and she will be made well.'<sup>51</sup> When He came into the house, He permitted no one to go in except Peter, James, and John, and the father and mother of the girl.<sup>52</sup> Now all wept and mourned for her; but He said, 'Do not weep; she is not dead, but sleeping.'<sup>53</sup> And they ridiculed Him, knowing that she was dead.<sup>54</sup> But He put them all outside, took her by the hand and called, saying, 'Little girl, arise.'<sup>55</sup> Then her spirit returned, and she arose immediately. And He commanded that she be given something to eat.<sup>56</sup> And her parents were astonished, but He charged them to tell no one what had happened." (Luke 8:49-56 NKJV)*

## **Cultivate the climate of FAITH.**

*"... 'Do not be afraid; only believe, and she will be made well.' When He came into the house, He permitted no one to go in except Peter, James, and John, and the father and mother of the girl." (Luke 8:50-51 NKJV)*

*"But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him." (Hebrews 11:6 NKJV)*

## **Separate from and isolate the climate of FEAR.**

*"Now all wept and mourned for her; but He said, 'Do not weep; she is not dead, but sleeping.'<sup>53</sup> And they ridiculed Him, knowing that she was dead.<sup>54</sup> But He put them all outside..." (Luke 8:52-54 NKJV)*

*"For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind." (2 Timothy 1:7 NKJV)*

## **Internalize the PROMISES of God.**

*"He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.<sup>2</sup> I will say of the LORD, 'He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust'<sup>3</sup> Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler And from the perilous pestilence.<sup>4</sup> He shall cover you with His feathers, And under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler.<sup>5</sup> You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, Nor of the arrow that flies by day,<sup>6</sup> Nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, Nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday." (Psalm 91:1-6 NKJV)*

## **OBEY the call of God.**

*"And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, 'All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.<sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,<sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.' Amen." (Matthew 28:18-20 NKJV)*
