Grace Group Discussion Guide

For the week of July 22-28, 2018

Main Thought and Passages:

The saying, "God helps those who help themselves" is misleading. It could lead us to think that we need to "make it on our own," or "pull ourselves up by our bootstraps." While we certainly need to work hard and be diligent, the pursuit of what we want could cause us to be disobedient and unfaithful to God. It could cause us to push Him aside in pursuit of what we want. The truth is, God helps those who obey Him and are faithful. David was anointed to be the King of Israel, yet he spent many more years obediently and faithfully serving the current, wicked king Saul, and as a shepherd over his father's sheep. Instead of trying to help himself by "seizing his own destiny" or "making it happen" on his own, David simply remained obedient and faithful to God, and God promoted him. God has a purpose and destiny for us all that He brings about as we are obedient and faithful to Him.

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight." (Proverbs 3:5-6 NIV)
