### **Main Thought:**

Many times in our journey of following Jesus, the enemy will attempt to break us right before a breakthrough takes place in our lives, relationships, businesses, and ministries. ### **Main Passages:**

*"Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour." (1 Peter 5:8 ESV)*

*"Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, 'I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.'" (John 8:12 ESV)*

*"Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." (Psalm 119:105 ESV)*

*"For so the Lord has commanded us, saying, 'I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth.'" (Acts 13:47 ESV)*
