# **Small Group Discussion Guide**

For the week of December 22 - 28, 2019

### Main Thought and Scripture:

The first Christmas happened during a very chaotic time. The Jews had been oppressed by the Romans for generations. Mary, a virgin, found out that she was pregnant by the Holy Spirit. No one believed her including her fiancé Joseph, who planned to call off the engagement until he was visited by an angel in a dream. Then, Mary and Joseph couldn't find a place for her to give birth and had to deliver their baby in a barn. The first Christmas shows us that God is near and wants to reveal Himself to us in a deeper way in the midst of chaos.
