Warm Up:

Who is the most generous person you know? What makes them generous?

Open in Prayer

Main Thought:

God is generous. He created everything by His hands, and He holds everything together with His hands. We often have a difficult time trusting God's generosity because we are more focused on what we don't have rather than what we already have. Because of this, we tend to become discontent instead of being grateful. God is a giver, it is His divine nature, and He doesn't change. The fullness of God's generosity was displayed on the cross, when He gave His Son to die for our sins. It is Christ's nail-pierced hands that show us what generosity truly looks like.

Main Passages:

"For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together." (Colossians 1:16-17)

"Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows." (James 1:17)

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16)

Scripture Exploration:

- What stands out to you from these passages? What do the scriptures say about God's generosity?

Personal Reflection:

- When have you experienced God's generosity in your life? How were you impacted by that?
- What is one area of your life where you struggle to be thankful?

Active Application:

- In light of God's generosity towards you, how can you live with gratitude?

Close in Prayer:

- Think about three things you are grateful for and thank God for it.
- Pray for healing and a spiritual awakening in our church, state, and nation, particularly in light of the recent NYC terrorist attack.
- Pray for those by name that you are sharing your faith with and believing will come to know God.
