The Lifestyle God Favors

43 And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. 44 And all who believed were together and had all things in common. 45 And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. 46 And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, 47 praising God and having favor with all the people. How does a lifestyle God favors look?

Liturgical lifestyle. (v. 42-43)

"And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles."

- A life of prayer.
 - "And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, he departed and went out to a desolate place, and there he prayed." (Mark 1:35 ESV)
- A life in the Word.
 - "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success." (Joshua 1:8 ESV)
- A life of fellowship.

Communal lifestyle. (v. 44-46)

"And all who believed were together and had all things **in common**. ⁴⁵And they were selling their **possessions** and **belongings** and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. ⁴⁶And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous heart..."

Missional lifestyle. (v. 47)

"...praising God and having **favor** with all the people. And **the Lord added** to their number day by day those who were being saved."

- They raised leaders.
