Martha, the sister of the dead man, said to him, 'Lord, by this time there will be an odor, for he has been dead four days.' ⁴⁰Jesus said to her, 'Did I not tell you that if you believed you would see the glory of God?' ⁴¹So they took away the stone. And Jesus lifted up his eyes and said, 'Father, I thank you that you have heard me. ⁴²I knew that you always hear me, but I said this on account of the people standing around, that they may believe that you sent me.' ⁴³When he had said these things, he cried out with a loud voice, 'Lazarus, come out.' ⁴⁴The man who had died came out, his hands and feet bound with linen strips, and his face wrapped with a cloth.
