"As Jesus looked up, he saw the rich putting their gifts into the temple treasury. <sup>2</sup>He also saw a poor widow put in two very small copper coins. <sup>3</sup>'Truly I tell you,' he said, 'this poor widow has put in more than all the others. <sup>4</sup>All these people gave their gifts out of their wealth; but she out of her poverty put in all she had to live on.'" (Luke 21:1-4 NIV)

## The grace to sacrifice comes from God and from <u>KNOWING</u> Him.

**Sacrifice** = The act of offering something precious. Surrender of something for the sake of something else.

# While people may never witness or show gratitude for your sacrifice, God <u>SEES</u> and is <u>PLEASED</u>.

"'Truly I tell you,' he said, 'this poor widow has put in more than all the others. All these people gave their gifts out of their wealth; but she out of her poverty put in all she had to live on.'" (v. 3-4)
