Stay Lit: For the week of March 22 - 28, 2020

Main Scripture and Thought:

"You are the light of the world—like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden. ¹⁵No one lights a lamp and then puts it under a basket. Instead, a lamp is placed on a stand, where it gives light to everyone in the house. ¹⁶In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father." (Matthew 5:14-16 NLT)

In a press conference on March 18, 2020, President Trump and his staff made multiple important announcements.
