

# Camp Impact 2018

## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: *When and where will camp be held?***

A: July 15-17 (Sunday afternoon to Tuesday afternoon)

**Q: *When and Where are the drop-off and pick-up times?***

A: Drop-off time and location: Sunday, July 15 from 12:30pm to 1:30pm, Main Campus; Pick-up time and location: Tuesday, July 17 from 3:00pm to 4:00pm, Main Campus

**Q: *How much does camp cost?***

A: All payment information is included in the registration guide.

**Q: *What is included in the costs?***

A: All meals, board, transportation, camp shirts & workbooks are provided for within the camp registration fee.

**Q: *How many youth are expected to attend?***

A: 150 youth from our Pearlside Ohana (Max. Capacity)

**Q: *Is the camp site safe?***

A: Absolutely! The campsite is isolated from the public, enclosed by a fence. We will also have 24-hour security on watch.

**Q: *What is the adult to youth ratio?***

A: We will have one adult per ten youth and all adults will be FBI pre-screened.

**Q: *What should my child bring?***

A: Please see attached packing list.

**Q: *Can my child attend part-time, without sleeping over?***

A: There will be no part-time attendance available. We would love to have your youth to fully attend to gain the entire experience.

**Q: *Can someone else pick up/drop off my youth?***

A: The only person(s) that are able to pick-up your youth are the designated person(s) on their registration form. Please bring valid ID.

**Q: *What happens if my child gets hurt?***

A: We will have first aid/CPR certified staff available at all times. When your child needs their assistance, we will call you to inform you of the injury and assess whether or not your child needs to be picked up. If it is an emergency, we will call the emergency contact on your registration form and may call an ambulance.

**Q: *What if my child gets sick at camp?***

A: Our first aid/CPR team will tend to your child. We will then call the emergency contact person indicated on the registration form and determine if your child needs to be picked up. If they do, you will need to arrange for their transportation.

**Q: *Are there disciplinary procedures for misbehaving?***

A: We will have behavioral standards and rules for the youth. Our standard procedure is to allow your child's camp mentor to address any adverse behavior directly, and then to allow a member of our pastoral staff to address them. If your child continues to behave in such a way that is disrespectful to camp staff and harmful to other youth, we will require you to pick them up from camp, with no refund of camp fees. This policy is subject to the camp team's discretion, based on the situation.

**Q: *Can parents/any adults volunteer?***

A: Yes, we gladly welcome parents to volunteer. We need help in the areas of prayer, hospitality, and food preparation. If you would like to volunteer, please sign-up and fill out a FBI-background check form. We would also greatly appreciate donations of snacks and small food items. Unfortunately, due to limited capacity, you can volunteer per-diem but cannot stay overnight.

**Q: *What if I pay for registration and have to cancel?***

A: Full refunds are available up to July 1, 2018. After that, there will be no refunds for camp registration fees.

**Q: *Are the youth allowed to bring cell phones?***

A: Yes, but their use at camp will be limited to emergencies only.
